## Tell

**What You Need:** Low step stool or small sturdy box

### What You Do:

- Place the stool or box in various areas around your home.
- Stand with your child as they step on the stool or box and shout, "Jesus wants to be my friend forever!"
- Then, you take a turn too. Everyone in the family can participate.

**What You Need:** Sad and happy

Activity Page, red washable paint, toilet paper tubes, paper plates

### What You Do:

- Cut tubes into 1 ½" pieces and bend into smiley mouths.
- Pour some paint on the plates.
- Encourage children to make a sad mouth and a happy mouth with the tube then use their fingerprints to make a heart.

### What You Say:

"When Jesus' friends heard He had to go away, they were sad. Hold your tube up to make a sad face. Now dip that into the paint then onto the first circle.

"But Jesus promised that He would come back, and He did! This made Jesus' friends very happy. Hold your tube up to make a happy face. Now dip that into the paint then onto the second circle.

"Jesus is alive, and He wants to be your friend forever. Let's make a heart with your fingerprints on the last circle.
